to form this easy bar chord place your index finger across the 7th fret,
and then place your middle finger on the 8th fret, and finally just put your ring and pinky on the 9th fret just as so much you make a clean sound.

Some people have told me that it his hard to put enough pressure on the string. you can either get a lighter gauge string or put your thumb on the neck and squeeze hard.

Interlude:

this is a pretty easy pattern that moves up and down the neck.
